Conditions of Sale

The CMS welcomes items of cricket memorabilia for its auctions. There will normally be just two auctions in the year - March and October.

The CMS reserves the right to refuse items which are damaged etc., or we have doubts about authenticity.

Reserves can be placed on lots but must be agreed with the CMS. They should reflect realistic values/expectations and not be the "highest price" expected.

The CMS will take 7% of the price realised, the vendor 93% which will normally be paid 6 weeks after the auction.

The CMS will undertake to advertise the memorabilia to all its members (including overseas) and only CMS members are eligible to bid for items.

Members are welcome to send postal bids which should be in writing/e-mail before the auction. Bids will normally start at 60% of the lower estimate unless there is a higher reserve price or other postal bids.

Items will be sent to successful postal bidders the week after the auction and will usually be sent by recorded delivery. Postage will be paid by the successful postal bidder.

The CMS will be responsible for the items sent for auction while they are in the possession of the CMS.

The CMS welcomes items of particular and unusual interest for the auctions. Non-members can send items for auction but we would discourage large quantities of books, magazines etc.

A list of prices realised at an auction will be displayed on the Society's website after the auction.

- 12. Scorecard** of a Match at Hampshire County Cricket Ground July 1886 between Hampshire and Norfolk. The card is completed in type and in excellent condition. Est. £18/25
- 13. Copies of a Victorian Staffordshire Style Ornaments (c1960).** A batsman with blue Jacket and a wicketkeeper with yellow jacket together with a batsman with green Jacket and a bowler with a white jacket. The ornaments are both in excellent condition and stand 16cms high. Est. £12/15
- 14. Small Mug by Lancaster and Sandland** decorated with an early cricketer and a verse in praise of cricket. The mug stands 10cms high, in very good condition with excellent gilding. Est. £4/6

15. Original Scorebook from 1956 containing the complete record of the Fourth Test at Old Trafford against Australia (Laker's Test). The pages are signed by Alan Oakman and Jim Laker. Numerous other first class matches, not necessarily complete, are recorded over a period of 1955 to 1970 including the 1955 Test Match against South Africa also at Old Trafford. Apart from the official scorebooks this may be the only complete record of Old Trafford Test Match and therefore unique. The scorebook has been used over several years and shows some wear but the key pages are clean and easy to read. Est. £150/200

16. Model of Lord's Cricket Ground 1998 by Alan Mynall for the Danbury Mint and authorised by the MCC. The set is accompanied by a certificate of authenticity No 3479 with technical details. All coins feature the Ian Rank-Broadley portrait of Elizabeth II with the legend ELIZABETH II AUSTRALIA 2001 with the denomination below. The reverses all feature Sir Donald Bradman and all have the legend SIR DONALD BRADMAN 1908 2001: The central coin is a Twenty Dollar bi-metal gold and silver piece depicting a bust of Sir Donald wearing the baggy green cap of the Australian Cricket Team in 1931 - 1932 (struck at the Perth Mint). The coin on the left is a silver proof Five Dollar depicting Sir Donald playing a cover drive (struck at the Perth Mint). The coin on the right is an Aluminium-Zinc bronze uncirculated Five Dollar depicting Sir Donald completing a pull shot (struck at the Royal Australian Mint, Canberra). Gold 99.99 pure silver 99.9 pure. Est. £200/250
